After her healing and remarriage, Krista began her ministry of supporting and encouraging the brokenhearted. She led a local Divorce Care group and became the Care Group Ministry Director. During this time she ministered to teens through "The Big D/ivorce", and also to children through "DC4K" (Divorce Care for Kids) program. Krista and her husband, Jon, started a Marriage Ministry at their local church and led small groups, blended family intensives, marriage retreats and seminars, and became premarital coaches through "Prepare & Enrich". Krista also published "The Big D/ivorce: Divorce Thru the Eyes of a Teen" as a group curriculum and is the creator of "The Slippery Slope" interactive board game. Recently she developed "Journey Through Divorce", a web portal that offers tools, resources and a communication tool for those experiencing separation or divorce. Krista spends her days running a family manufacturing business and resides in Big Lake, MN with her 4 children. Her husband, Jon, passed away tragically from Amyloidosis in June of 2012. Through this most recent tragedy she has developed an even deeper heart for the brokenhearted.

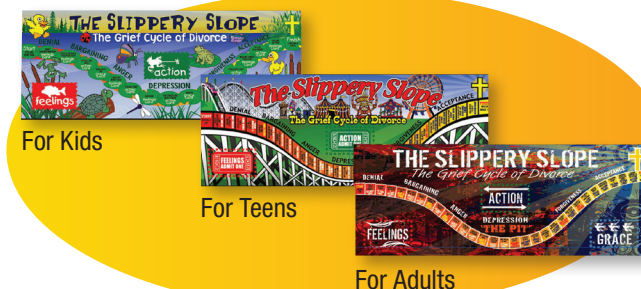
